Coral I and Coral II Itinerary 5 Days B

| Days | Activities |

| 1 | Santa Cruz Highlands: Upon arriving to Baltra Airport, you will be transferred to the pier to board the Coral I or Coral II. After lunch, a bus will transfer you to the Highlands of Santa Cruz, where you will see Galapagos Giant Tortoises in their natural habitat. After this activity head back to the yacht for dinner. |
| 2 | Punta Espinoza and Punta Vicente Roca: First activity of the day will be heading to Punta Vicente Roca, a wonderful snorkeling site, where you can see turtles and various species of fish. After lunch, head to Punta Espinoza at Fernandina Island, that is one of the youngest islands with the most active volcano, and where you can spot pelicans, sea lions and marine iguanas. After this activity you will have dinner at the yacht and rest. |
| 3 | Tagus Cove and Urbina Bay: Early in the morning, you will visit Urbina Bay, one of the recent examples of geological uplift in the Galapagos, and it's also a seasonal nesting area for many tortoises and Galapagos Penguins. During the afternoon, you will head to Tagus Cove in Isabela Island, that used to be a hide-out and deep-water anchorage in the days of the pirates. Here you will go for a hike to the top of a cliff to view the volcanic landscapes of Darwin Volcano and Darwin Lake. After these activities head back to the yacht for dinner. |
| 4 | Puerto Egas and Sullivan Bay: First activity of the day will be wet landing at James Bay also known as Port Egas, where an easy walk will take you to observe iguanas and sea lions in the coast line. You can also swim or snorkel here. During the afternoon, the yacht will land in Sullivan Bay at Santiago Island where you can witness the rope lava flows, and sea lions that rest through the shore. You can also practice shallow water snorkeling here. After his activities head back to the yacht for dinner. |
| 5 | Bachas Beach: Early in the morning, head to Bachas Beach, with a lagoon behind the high tide line, where you can watch marine iguanas and flamingoes, and is also a nesting area for green sea turtles form November to February. After this activity, you will be transferred to Baltra Airport and take your flight back to the continent. |


