| 1 | Santa Cruz Island: Upon your arrival to Baltra Airport, a guide will be waiting for you to take you to Silberstein Hotel. Once you arrive you will settle in the hotel and have lunch at Aqua Bar –Restaurant. In the afternoon, you will be transferred to Charles Darwin Research Station, where you will learn about the conservation efforts that have been made in the island to preserve the tortoise's species. End of the day and dinner at Aqua Restaurant. |
| 2 | Day Tour to an uninhabited island (Bartolome, North Seymour, South Plaza or Santa Fe, based on availability). Bartolome: One of the youngest and smallest islands at the Archipelago, you can climb to the highest point of this spot to have a magnificent view of the entire island, along Pinnacle Rock, one of the most beautiful sites in the entire Archipelago North Seymour: This island was formed by an uplift and it has a circular path which you can take while seeing frigate birds courting the females, and also blue footed boobies that also nest here South Plaza: With just 1ft mt wide, it is formed by a white sand beach and black lava at its coast. You can take a trek to the highest point at the island from which you can see various species of birds. You can also spot marine iguanas, land iguanas and hybrids of this species. Santa Fe: This is a central island, that has as a visit place an incredible bay of turquoise water, protected by a natural coral barrier, where you can spot sea lion colonies. This place is home to one of the two species of marine iguanas that reside in the islands. This is an excellent spot to snorkel along sea turtles, sea lions and various species of fish |

| 5 | Day Tour to an uninhabited island (Bartolome, North Seymour, South Plaza or Santa Fe, based on availability). |
| 6 | Day tour based on availability to Tintoreras Islet: Early in the morning you will be transferred to Isabela Island, and then you will visit Tintoreras Islet, in a bay tour where you will observe blue footed boobies, sea lions, and Galapagos penguins. Then you will land at this islet, to take a walk to a canal where you will see from up close white tipped reef sharks, also called "tintoreras" hence the name of this island. In the afternoon you will go to Isabela's Tortoise Breeding Center. |
| 7 | Santa Cruz Island: First activity of the day will be going to Santa Cruz Highlands, where you will visit a ranch to see Galapagos Giant Tortoises roaming freely. In the afternoon you will do a 45-minute walk to Tortuga Bay beach, where you can just relax at the shore or swim. |
| 8 | Baltra Airport: After breakfast you will be transferred to the airport to take your flight back to the continent |
